

Cambridge University Bowmen (CUB) Beginner Bow Rent to Own

THE SCHEME

The club has a small number of new sets of equipment available for beginner archers to hire and subsequently (should they desire) purchase. These kits are a fantastic opportunity for someone new to the sport to buy all the essentials at a low price and with ease, as the club will be selling them at or below cost.

Beginners who take advantage of this hire scheme will not need to use equipment that any other archer uses in a different session. They can clean, maintain and adjust their equipment (with advice available from the club) at their leisure.

Beginners who purchase the kit will leave the beginners course not only with the knowledge and skills to shoot effectively, but also their own equipment. This will enable them to hit the ground running as an archer and shoot with the club without having to hire equipment after the beginners course.

ELIGIBILITY

Archers are eligible for this scheme if they are taking the beginners course in Michaelmas 2020.

THE EQUIPMENT

The kit contains all the items required by the beginner archer, including:

- A wooden riser with arrow rest
- Limbs
- String
- Finger tab
- Finger sling

- Arm guard
- Stringer
- Sight
- Bag

Arrows are not included in this kit and can be obtained from the club supply. The cost of a beginner setup like this is typically around £80 from a specialist shop.

THE COST

The kits will be rented at a standard price of £20 per term.

Archers who wish to purchase the kit can do so by contacting the <u>equipment officers</u> at any time during the beginners course. The club will charge £60 to the archer for the sale of the equipment.
